

Ordinance No. 1

An Ordinance regulating the use of boats with motors on Timm's Lake.

The Town Board of the Town of Niagara do ordain as follows:

Section 1. During the hours between 11:A.M. and 7:P.M. it shall be lawful to use any type of motor with any given horse power on Timm's Lake in the Town of Niagara, County of Marinette, Wisconsin.

Section 2. During the hours from 7:P.M. until 9:P.M. it shall be unlawful to use any motor which has a braking horse power in excess of $7\frac{1}{2}$.

Section 3. During the hours from 9:P.M. until 7:A.M. it shall be unlawful to use any motor on Timm's Lake.

Section 4. During the hours between 7:A.M. and 11:A.M. it shall be unlawful to use any motor on Timm's Lake which has a braking horse power in excess of $7\frac{1}{2}$.

Section 5. The above sections shall not apply to any case in which there is an actual emergency requiring a motor in violation of this ordinance. The times referred to above shall be central standard time, or central standard daylight saving time, which ever is in use in this particular town at any given time.

Section 6. Failure to comply with this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not exceeding 10 days.

Passed And Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Niagara, this 2th day of Aug., 1959.

This ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon posting and publication as required by law.
