Weight Limit Ordinance
2013-10-A

The Town Board of the Town of Niagara, Marinette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. [349.16](#), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, establishes special or seasonal weight limits as follows:

- A. The Niagara Town Board has established weight regulations not in excess of 14,000 pounds per vehicle on any or all Town Roads under the jurisdiction of the Niagara Town Board. These restrictions are to remain in effect until duly cancelled by the authority of the Town Board.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall erect signs as required under s. [349.16 \(2\)](#), Wis. stats., on or before the effective date.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the above-noted weight limits without a written permit issued by the Town Board of the Town of Niagara. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture as required, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on publication: October 17, 2013.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. [60.80](#), Wis. stats.
