Ordinance #2

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE COMPUTING OF THE TAX RATE:

The Town Board of the town of Niagara do ordain as follows:

referring to Section 70.65 of the law book: “wherever the common council or other governing body of any city, Town or Village in the State shall direct, the aggregate amount of state, county and local taxes shall be carried in a single column in the tax roll opposite the parcel or tract of land against which the tax is levied, or, in case of personal property in a single column opposite the name of the person, firm or corporation against whom the said tax is levied.

Section 2: In which case there shall be printed or stamped on the tax receipt the separate proportion or rate of taxes levied for state, county, school and other purposes.
